- Reconstruct WIS 83 into a 4-lane divided roadway
- Limits: 1/4 mile south of the bridge over Union Pacific Railroad / Vettelson Road to Campus Drive
- New signalized intersections at Capitol Drive, Eastbound and Westbound ramps, and Campus Drive
- New Southbound bridge over Union Pacific Railroad / Vettelson Road
- New bridges over WIS 16 highway
- New retaining walls at bridges over WIS 16 highway
- Improvement of turn lanes on WIS 83, side roads, and ramps
- Rehabilitation of ramp pavement
- Addition of sidewalk and shared use path; shared use path on west side of WIS 83 extends south to Cardinal Lane

You're invited to attend a public involvement meeting regarding the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's (WisDOT) plans for improvements to WIS 83 from ¼ mile south of the bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad/Vettelson Road to Campus Drive, including the WIS 83 and WIS 16 interchange in Waukesha County. (See attached project location map). The meeting is scheduled as follows:

Date: Wednesday, August 20, 2014

Time: 4 p.m. – 7 p.m.

Location: Hartland Village Board Room, 210 Cottonwood Ave., Hartland

The meeting will have an "open house" format to allow interested persons an opportunity to meet individually with WisDOT representatives and to view exhibits displaying pertinent information regarding the project.

The proposed improvements are scheduled for construction in 2017-2018 and will include reconstructing WIS 83 into a 4-lane divided roadway. Traffic signals at the intersections will be replaced, new bridges will be constructed, and turn lanes will be improved along WIS 83 and the intersecting side roads and ramps. The entrance and exit ramp pavement will also be replaced. In addition, sidewalk and a shared use path will be constructed, with a shared use path along the west side of WIS 83 extending south to the Cardinal Lane intersection.

This meeting is an opportunity to ask questions, exchange information and offer comments regarding the project. All interested persons are cordially invited to attend.
