Snow Plow Service

Plowing of public and private roads is done as needed to ensure access for emergency vehicles, and safe passage for other vehicles. The Village plows the private drives as a supplement to the plowing of the public roads and streets. It is not intended to be of the quality that may be available from some commercial services. The Village driveway plowing service has budget and manpower limitations. As a result, we may not be able to meet all possible requests of all residents. If you have specific or unique requests, you may need to contract with a commercial plowing service.

- The plowing and salting of private driveways is a unique service that normally begins when the storm subsides.
- Driveway plowing is systematically done to provide this service in an efficient and economical manner. It takes between 6 and 12 hours to service the entire Village, depending on conditions. The Village does not have the resources to guarantee that private driveways will be plowed by any particular time of day.
- The Village uses part time employees to assist with snowplowing. Due to turnover of personnel, it becomes difficult to memorize each resident's driveway design. Please mark your driveway edges and objects that become hidden under snow banks, such as stumps or landscape lights. Unmarked drives will not be plowed if the driver cannot determine which areas should be plowed.
- Vehicles and other obstructions must be removed, or your drive will be passed by until clear.
- The Village does not plow or salt by outbuildings or close to garage doors.
- Residents can help themselves by placing barrels at steep or hazardous locations. These barrels will be filled with a sand/salt mix by the Village upon request.
- Any Obstructions or brush within 2 feet of the driveway must be removed. If you are unable to move these obstructions we ask that you clearly mark them
