Stat. §§7.51 and 7.53(1). This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§19.81-89.

If needed, the Municipal Board of Canvassers will also hold a meeting at 4:00 p.m. in the Village Office to process and count late-arriving provisional ballots (if any) that arrived in our office by mail on Friday, February 23, 2018.
