<u>Village of Chenequa Official Notice</u> Spring Primary Election Location, Hours of Polling Place and Board of Canvassers

The polls will be open for the Spring Primary Election to be held on February 16, 2021 from 7:00am to 8:00pm. Voting will take place at the Chenequa Village Hall located at 31275 W County Road K in the Village of Chenequa. Polling place is accessible to elderly and disabled voters.

At the close of Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as a joint meeting of the Municipal Board of Canvassers (MBOC) for the purpose of conducting the municipal canvass pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 7.51 and 7.53(1). This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 19.81-89.

If needed, the (MBOC) will also hold a meeting at 4:00pm in the Village Office to process and count late-arriving provisional ballots (if any) that arrived in our office by mail on Friday, February 19, 2021.

Forestry Department

Just a reminder, as always, no cutting of trees, brush, or any vegetation is allowed within 75' of a waterway in the Village without a permit. The purpose of this is to prevent erosion, filter runoff before it goes to the water, maintain healthy aquatic ecosystem, and preserve the natural beauty of all the shorelines.

The Village of Chenequa employs two foresters that would be more than happy to meet with any resident on-site to help out with any tree-related questions you may have.
