Boating Reminders

Reminder for everyone: all powered boats operating on any public waterway in the State of Wisconsin must have a Wisconsin Certificate of Number (registration) and expiration decals to operate a recreational vessel legally. The Certificate of Number (registration card) must be on board and available for inspection by an enforcement officer

The registration number and expiration decals must be displayed as follows:

- Numbers must be placed on each side of the forward half of the vessel.
- Number must be read from left to right.

whenever the vessel is operated.

- Number must be at least 3" high BLOCK letters.
- Numbers must contrast with the color of the vessel and be clearly visible and legible.
- Letters must be separated from the numbers by a space at least two inches wide.
- Decals must be affixed three inches behind (toward the stern) and in line with the number
- Two-tones and camouflage numbers are not legal and should not be used.

Soliciting in the Village

In accordance with Section 2.2 of the Village of Chenequa Ordinances, any individual who, personally or for any other person, organization, society, association or corporation, goes to private residences and distributes literature or solicits money, services, financial assistance or orders for the sale of goods or services is considered a solicitor. Solicitors are required to have a permit to engage in or sponsor solicitation within the Village of Chenequa. Each Solicitor shall possess prominently display a valid Solicitor's Permit. This permit is requested at the Village Hall during normal business hours. The Village does keep track of any and all valid Chenequa Solicitor Permits.
