RAFTS AND BUOYS:

No person shall erect or maintain any raft, platform or buoy more than one hundred (100) feet from the shore unless it is so anchored that it has at least ten (10) inches of free board above the water line, and either (i) is painted white and has attached thereto not less than twelve (12) inches from each corner or projection a red reflector in good condition not less than three (3) inches in diameter, or (ii) is painted with a band at least three inches in width of luminous paint so as to be visible from any direction. The proper buoys should be white with a blue stripe as pictured above.

#### **Does Your Driveway Meet Emergency Standards?**

Next time you drive down your driveway, please take a moment to look at the surrounding vegetation. Spring and summer rains have resulted in excessive growth and has caused many driveways to begin to "tunnel in". In the event of an emergency, all driveways need to be large enough to support an emergency vehicle. This means that brush and tree limbs must be cleared to allow for a **12'W x 12'H opening**. Failure to do this can result in slower response times and damaged emergency equipment.

Additionally, please be mindful of the condition of your pavement. Driveways that are cracked or developing potholes are extremely taxing on the village plow equipment and should be considered for repair or replacement.



# Pine Lake Boat Launch Closed November 1- 20, 2021

Starting Monday, November 1, 2021, the Pine Lake public boat launch will be closed for maintenance, repairs and improvements. It is estimated that the boat launch will remain closed until Saturday, November 20, 2021. During this closure, boat launching or retrieving from the public launch will not be possible.

It is advised that all piers and boats be removed from the water by October 31, 2021. The Village will work to notify area marine services. However, it is recommended that you reach out to your service provider to ensure your boat(s) and pier(s) are removed prior to October 31<sup>st</sup>.

After November 20<sup>th</sup> the launch will re-open for normal use. While unlikely, it is important to keep in mind that the north bay of Pine Lake may be iced over by the time the launch ramp reopens. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.
