## New USB Malware Threat

We recently have learned of a growing cyber threat using USB devices that are designed to release malware when plugged into a computer system.

According to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), a cyber-criminal group by the name of FIN7 has been targeting US businesses by sending nefarious USB devices to individuals by mail accompanied by fictitious letters claiming to be from the US Department of Health and Human Services with information on COVID-19 guidelines, or fake gifts with forged Amazon thank you gift cards.



## Forestry Department

Just a reminder, as always, no cutting of trees, brush, or any vegetation is allowed within 75' of a waterway in the Village without a permit. The purpose of this is to prevent erosion, filter runoff before it goes to the water, maintain a healthy aquatic ecosystem, and preserve the natural beauty of all the shorelines.

The Village of Chenequa employs two foresters that would be more than happy to meet with any resident on-site to help with any tree-related questions you may have.
