Forestry News

If there is any Oak / Elm pruning you wish to do on your property, **please make sure it is completed by April** 15<sup>th</sup>.

The warmer weather will activate sap and bark beetles which are known to spread Oak Wilt and Dutch Elm disease. The beetles are attracted to the wound of a fresh cut tree.

A good rule of thumb is don't prune oaks and elms between April 15<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup>. If you must prune between these dates, you must seal the wound with pruning seal immediately.
