# VILLAGE OF CHENEQUA ORDINANCE NO. 2022-10-10-03

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8 OF THE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING PROTECTION OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Chapter 8 of the Village Code sets forth regulations regarding persons and property; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to amend Chapter 8 of the Village Code to incorporate certain state criminal laws to promote public health, safety and general welfare in the Village of Chenequa;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Village Board of the Village of Chenequa, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain and adopt a new Section 8.26 of the Village Code to incorporate certain state criminal laws to promote public health, safety and general welfare in the Village of Chenequa as follows:

#### **SECTION 1**

A new Section 8.26 shall be added to the Village Code and shall state as follows:

# 8.26 State Statutes Adopted.

The following Wisconsin statutory provisions describing and defining regulations regarding certain misdemeanors, together with all amendments, revisions and modifications thereto (exclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties or punishments to be imposed for a violation of the statutes except as otherwise set forth below) are hereby incorporated into the Village Code of the Village of Chenequa and made a part of this Chapter. ## **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY**

If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

### **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
