All seven member communities (City of Delafield, Town of Delafield, Village of Chenequa, Village of Nashotah, Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Village of Wales and the Town of Genesee) officially signed the Lake Country Fire & Rescue (LCFR) Intermunicipal Agreement (IMA) on June 3, 2026.

This historic milestone follows more than three years of intensive negotiations, that resolved long-standing municipal budget, funding, and operational disputes, paving the way for a unified regional public safety model.
