Product Exchange Program Year-round Collection Sites

This program allows residents to take usable materials, such as cleaning and automotive products; new/usable paints and stains; lawn, garden and other household products, at NO CHARGE.

Quantities and types of materials available vary. You will be required to sign a Liability Waiver and Release Form.

Reminders

- Business, institutional, and agricultural waste will not be accepted through this program. For information on a special program for businesses, visit www.waukeshacounty.gov/recycling or call 262-896-8300.
- HHW collection is expensive, so this option should always be the "last resort."
- Try to use up the product or ask friends, family or neighbors if they need the product.
- Facility operators reserve the right to refuse any substance which cannot be disposed.
- Participants will be required to show ID and complete a short survey.
- Do not drop off materials except during regular operating hours.
- No appliances/white goods, computers/electronics – see website.
- DO NOT BRING LATEX PAINT.

Use caution in packing/ transporting materials

- 1. Keep products in original, labeled containers.
- 2. Don't mix any materials in the same container.
- 3. Box containers so they don't tip over during transportation.
- 4. Separate paint from other materials.
- 5. Keep materials away from children, pets and passengers.
